

Achiever

The Achiever award is the INCITE Awards' peak award and recognises an individual's outstanding contribution to the ICT industry in WA.

Nominees may include a Western Australian educator who has shown excellence in ICT education and demonstrated exceptional outcomes for both students and employers.

Past winners have included IS managers, academics and persons who have built significant ICT organisations in WA.

Nominations for this award may be made with or without the knowledge of the person being nominated.

Only the winner of this category will be announced at the Awards, but this may depend on the number and quality of entries. The Chief Judge will have final say on the number of candidates announced on an annual basis.

Depending on the decision of the INCITE Management Committee, this award as one of the honorary awards may be judged, awarded and announced at a different stage to the other INCITE category awards.
